

Legio Custodes Coronus Grav-Carrier

Armed with twin-linked lastrum bolt cannon and Arachnus blaze cannon, the Coronus Grav-carrier is perhaps one of the most recognised vehicles used exclusively by the Legio Custodes. This heavily protected transport skimmer provides them with a degree of speed and agility unmatched by the grinding armour of others who fight in the name of the Emperor, allowing the Legio Custodes to deploy rapidly into a range of terrain whilst reducing the risk of being pinned down by enemy forces.





Assembly Legend Parts for Assembly Glue Contact Area Do Not Glue Note Reverse Angle Insert Component Highlight


Preparing the Model for Assembly


Before assembling the model, wash each part thoroughly with an abrasive brush, such as a toothbrush, to remove any model release agent that may still be on the surface of the parts. Then, remove any excess resin such as mould lines, casting gates, vents and shims. For a more detailed guide to working with resin models, go to the Downloads section of the Forge World website.


This kit contains all the pieces required to construct a Coronus Grav-carrier. To glue the resin pieces together, use Citadel Super Glue.

NOTE: We have cast this kit using advanced techniques and the best quality resin, but due to the nature of the casting process, your model may contain small air bubbles. These can easily be filled with model filler or super glue. Any slight warpage of thin parts can easily be corrected by immersing the part in hot tap water for about 1 minute, then carefully bending it back into shape.


















Cannon
